President: George VanSyckle

Leader of the chapter and preside over meetings. Assures chapter representation at the Governing Board Meetings. Makes committee assignments and encourages membership growth.



Vice President: Dan Smyth

Assist Chapter President and serves as presiding officer in the absence of the President. In Central Florida Roadrunners, the Vice President is the Wagon Master who is responsible for planning and contracting our rally locations.



Secretary: Mary Eilrich

Chapter secretary keeps accurate, up to date records of the chapter's membership, the results of any election and annual chapter certification and reports to the National Office. Expected to keep a formal record, usually called minutes, of the proceedings of all meetings.



Treasurer: Joanna Smyth

Keeps accurate accounts of all chapter funds and disburses chapter funds for authorized chapter expenses.



National Director: Duane Maxwell

Keep chapter informed of items pertaining to the national organization and of the FMCA areas, as well as keeping the national organization apprised of items happening on the chapter level. Participation in and voting during Governing Board meetings.



Alternate National Director: Rusty LaBarre

Serve whenever the National Director is unable to attend meetings of the Governing Board or is otherwise unable to serve.
